**ABOUT KIDS' CAMP:** Kids' Camp offers children entering Kindergarten (must be 5 years old by September 1) through 6<sup>th</sup> Grades a day camp experience with activities including science and nature, sports and cooperative games, creative expression and crafts, drama and music, special interests, group times, and much more. Weekly excursions will include visits to local parks and beaches, swimming at Hardie Pool in Cayucos, and special adventures!

**HOURS:** Part-time positions working between 15-30 hours per week, Monday through Friday, between 6:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Positions begin on June 12<sup>th</sup> and run through August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 with a possible opportunity to work during the school year at the City's before & after-school program.

**PAY RATE:** Counselor-In-Training (high school students that have completed 9<sup>th</sup> grade): \$10.50 per hour.  
Camp Counselors (must be a high school graduate or equivalent): \$11.59 to \$12.77 per hour, depending on experience.  
Assistant Directors & Directors: \$13.06-\$14.48 per hour, depending on experience.

**JOB DESCRIPTION:** Camp staff are responsible for, but are not limited to, supervising children, working cooperatively with staff and parents, insuring proper maintenance, operation and safety of the site, assisting in preparing activities and excursions.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Qualified candidates must have knowledge of camp operations and age-appropriate activities. Previous employment in a day camp or childcare setting and Early Childhood Education preferred, especially for higher ranking positions.

**SELECTION PROCESS:** All applications received will be reviewed for accuracy, completion and job related qualifications. Those candidates possessing the most desirable qualifications will be invited to participate in an interview during May 15<sup>th</sup> through May 26<sup>th</sup>.
