<u>About the Position:</u> Under general supervision of the Aquatics Coordinator, provide a safe aquatic environment; rescue swimmers and assist other lifeguards in emergency response; check pool equipment, chemical levels, and report repair needs; maintain required paperwork; and, provide excellent customer service. Pool is located on the Morro Bay High School campus.

**Qualifications:** Strong swimmer; good physical condition. Successful applicants must possess the following required certifications:

- 1) American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certificate.
- 2) Minimum First Aid acceptable is 15 hours of certified training in compliance with Title 22 of California State Law.
- 3) Minimum CPR training acceptable is 9 hours of instruction—CPR for the Professional Rescuer or CPR for the Lifeguard (adult, child and infant CPR, use of breathing devices, AED and 2 rescuer CPR in compliance with Title 22 of the California State Law).

<u>Hours/Scheduling</u>: Early morning, noon, and evening hours available seven days a week. 2-25 hours per week with additional hours available during the summer.

<u>Application Process:</u> Applications may be obtained through the Morro Bay Recreation Services Division at 1001 Kennedy Way, the Morro Bay Human Resources Department at 595 Harbor Street, or online at <a href="http://www.morrobayca.gov/832/Employment-Opportunities">http://www.morrobayca.gov/832/Employment-Opportunities</a>. A City job application must be filled out completely and submitted along with copies of required certifications to the Recreation Services Division office at the above address.

<u>Selection/Testing Process</u>: All applications received will be reviewed for completeness, job related qualifications and proper certifications. Those candidates possessing the most desirable qualifications will be invited to participate in an oral interview. In-water skills assessment will take place at a later date. Morro Bay Recreation Services will administer all testing and interviews. Prior to being hired, all successful candidates must pass a background check, fingerprinting, and a pre-employment drug screen. Candidates under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

<u>Training</u>: Once hired, all staff will be required to attend mandatory in-service trainings.

**<u>Final Filing Date:</u>** Open until filled.
