STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS:

Prior to my retirement in October 2012, I was an employee of the City of Santa Rosa for twenty-six years in the General Services and Finance Departments. The final sixteen years of my career with the City of Santa Rosa were in the Purchasing Agent's office and my title at time of retirement was Buyer.

My Buyer duties included providing customer services to staff in all city departments to plan, develop and execute procurement processes for the purchase of goods, services and minor public works contracting in compliance with all applicable legal and ethical standards and requirements. These services included pre-procurement market and product research, assistance with specification and requirements development, preparing and issuing bid written bid solicitations and contracts, and drafting written bid award recommendations for the various award authorities including City Council staff reports and resolutions.

During my public purchasing career I was exposed to and learned quite a lot about how local government functions and is funded. For example, I understand differences between General Fund organizations (Police, Fire, Public Works, Parks and Recreation) and Enterprise and Grant funded organizations (Utilities, Transit). Most, if not all, California cities experienced serious funding shortfalls during the Great Recession especially in the General Fund from greatly reduced property and sales tax revenues. These funding shortfalls resulted in staff reductions and a backlog of unfulfilled operational and infrastructure needs that are challenging cities like Morro Bay to meet various service obligations to its citizens.

As a volunteer member of the Citizen Oversight Committee (Measure Q)/Citizens Finance Committee, I believe that I can draw upon my prior work experience as a staff member in local government to help the City of Morro Bay with citizen oversight of Measure Q funding expenditures and provide input related to other budget issues before this committee. The Mayor and City Council's consideration of me for this position is greatly appreciated.

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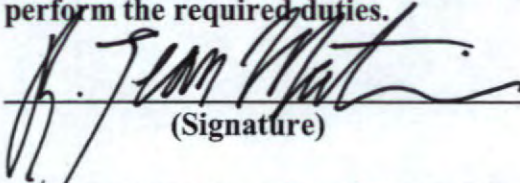

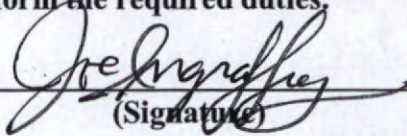

Re: Advisory Board Vacancies

To Members of the Morro Bay City Council;

I have been a regular visitor to the Morro Bay and Cayucos since I was young boy. My wife and I purchased a second home in Morro Bay several years ago with the intention of ultimately retiring in the area. We made the final retirement move in late July of this year. The environment is beautiful, of course, and the community has been very welcoming.

Now to the business of who I am and what interests and resources I might be able to bring to a Morro Bay advisory committees. By formal education and training I am a lawyer, a member in good standing with the California Bar Association and a 1976 graduate of the UCLA School of Law. My areas of emphasis were federal taxation, real estate development and entertainment law. Immediately after graduation I worked as a transactional attorney in the legal department of Capitol Records, Inc. Because of an abiding fascination with film production, in 1977 I opted to explore a career switch and to participate in a Directors Guild of America apprenticeship program. Upon graduation from the DGA program in 1979, I became an assistant director. I worked in that capacity for 25 years, organizing, budgeting and expediting all manner of productions, commercials, television series, television movies, big and small budget features in Los Angeles, on distant location throughout the country and in Europe. The bulk of the productions have long since faded from the public's consciousness. However, some of the more memorable ones included the series: *Magnum P.I.*, *Murder She Wrote*, *Colombo* and *ER*. The most succinct description of the job responsibilities I can manage is that I did everything the director didn't want to do, didn't know how to do or didn't even know he should do. Confronting the unknown, constant change and speedy accommodations were always the orders of the day. It was fulfilling and maddening, often simultaneously. However, the common perception that film production is essentially a young person's world is correct. I hung up my assistant director hat a few years back and went to work as a real-estate broker, mostly residential brokerage for Colwell Banker with some commercial sales thrown in on occasion. In 2007, in a surprising turn of events, I was offered the directorship of the media department at Providence High School, a small Catholic school in Burbank, California. The school had been one of the first to establish a complete film production program for high school students and already had a robust curriculum and impressive reputation when I arrived. I was both the director and the sole instructor to approximately 85 students participating in the program. I guided the student productions, fostered ties with the neighboring studios, produced our annual film festival and, in general, did everything that I could to ensure that the graduating students got into colleges and programs of their choices. I continued in that capacity for eight years, capping my tenure at Providence with

the supervision of a \$1.5 million capital improvement to the media complex completed in August, 2015.

Now I find myself in Morro Bay with time on my hands and the usual inclination to get things done. To be honest, I don't have any prior experience working on municipal advisory committees. What I do have in 40 plus years of analytical thinking and counseling all sorts of "clients" about they should be doing, problem solving, budgeting and planning and completing productions, always under circumstances of inadequate time and resources. In addition, it always seemed to me, in both film production and in teaching, that my responsibilities far exceeded my authority, which is a good working definition of constant stress. I would also like to add that in each of my four disparate careers, persuasion, consensus building and leadership by example were required in abundance, far more than any coercive power associated with a given job title.

That's a thumbnail history of what I've done and I've probably gone on at too great a length about it. As to who I am, let me try a less self-serving approach. As I have gotten older I've collected a handful of aphorisms that I find useful and try to follow each day. Here is a sampling of some of the essentials according to Joe.

There is no substitute for enthusiasm. If by nature you are not enthusiastic, then learn to fake it.

Examine every situation for the opportunity that it presents.

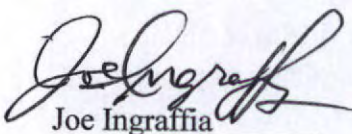
Ask frequently what more can I do.

Life is not a path, it's a wide and raging river.

Laugh often.

Call, because they won't.

There you have it. As a newcomer, I think I would lend an insightful and fresh outlook to the issues and opportunities that arise in quiet Morro Bay. By training, experience, and inclination that insight and outlook are likely to be well-considered. Those same attributes make me well suited to deal with uncertainty, stresses and divergent opinions vehemently expressed in a political arena. I think my enthusiasm would translate into a willingness to roll up my sleeves and work. I'm interested in preserving the ambiance of Morro Bay while mindful that change and growth are inevitable. The trick is to achieve a balance that's consistent and smart. I'm particularly interested in what the future may have in store for the power plant. I'm also interested in exploring ideas for additional sources of revenue for city administration. I look forward to the interview and the opportunity.

Re: Advisory Board Vacancies

To Members of the Morro Bay City Council;

I have been a regular visitor to the Morro Bay and Cayucos since I was young boy. My wife and I purchased a second home in Morro Bay several years ago with the intention of ultimately retiring in the area. We made the final retirement move in late July of this year. The environment is beautiful, of course, and the community has been very welcoming.

Now to the business of who I am and what interests and resources I might be able to bring to a Morro Bay advisory committees. By formal education and training I am a lawyer, a member in good standing with the California Bar Association and a 1976 graduate of the UCLA School of Law. My areas of emphasis were federal taxation, real estate development and entertainment law. Immediately after graduation I worked as a transactional attorney in the legal department of Capitol Records, Inc. Because of an abiding fascination with film production, in 1977 I opted to explore a career switch and to participate in a Directors Guild of America apprenticeship program. Upon graduation from the DGA program in 1979, I became an assistant director. I worked in that capacity for 25 years, organizing, budgeting and expediting all manner of productions, commercials, television series, television movies, big and small budget features in Los Angeles, on distant location throughout the country and in Europe. The bulk of the productions have long since faded from the public's consciousness. However, some of the more memorable ones included the series: *Magnum P.I.*, *Murder She Wrote*, *Colombo* and *ER*. The most succinct description of the job responsibilities I can manage is that I did everything the director didn't want to do, didn't know how to do or didn't even know he should do. Confronting the unknown, constant change and speedy accommodations were always the orders of the day. It was fulfilling and maddening, often simultaneously. However, the common perception that film production is essentially a young person's world is correct. I hung up my assistant director hat a few years back and went to work as a real-estate broker, mostly residential brokerage for Colwell Banker with some commercial sales thrown in on occasion. In 2007, in a surprising turn of events, I was offered the directorship of the media department at Providence High School, a small Catholic school in Burbank, California. The school had been one of the first to establish a complete film production program for high school students and already had a robust curriculum and impressive reputation when I arrived. I was both the director and the sole instructor to approximately 85 students participating in the program. I guided the student productions, fostered ties with the neighboring studios, produced our annual film festival and, in general, did everything that I could to ensure that the graduating students got into colleges and programs of their choices. I continued in that capacity for eight years, capping my tenure at Providence with

the supervision of a \$1.5 million capital improvement to the media complex completed in August, 2015.

Now I find myself in Morro Bay with time on my hands and the usual inclination to get things done. To be honest, I don't have any prior experience working on municipal advisory committees. What I do have in 40 plus years of analytical thinking and counseling all sorts of "clients" about they should be doing, problem solving, budgeting and planning and completing productions, always under circumstances of inadequate time and resources. In addition, it always seemed to me, in both film production and in teaching, that my responsibilities far exceeded my authority, which is a good working definition of constant stress. I would also like to add that in each of my four disparate careers, persuasion, consensus building and leadership by example were required in abundance, far more than any coercive power associated with a given job title.

That's a thumbnail history of what I've done and I've probably gone on at too great a length about it. As to who I am, let me try a less self-serving approach. As I have gotten older I've collected a handful of aphorisms that I find useful and try to follow each day. Here is a sampling of some of the essentials according to Joe.

There is no substitute for enthusiasm. If by nature you are not enthusiastic, then learn to fake it.

Examine every situation for the opportunity that it presents.

Ask frequently what more can I do.

Life is not a path, it's a wide and raging river.

Laugh often.

Call, because they won't.

There you have it. As a newcomer, I think I would lend an insightful and fresh outlook to the issues and opportunities that arise in quiet Morro Bay. By training, experience, and inclination that insight and outlook are likely to be well-considered. Those same attributes make me well suited to deal with uncertainty, stresses and divergent opinions vehemently expressed in a political arena. I think my enthusiasm would translate into a willingness to roll up my sleeves and work. I'm interested in preserving the ambiance of Morro Bay while mindful that change and growth are inevitable. The trick is to achieve a balance that's consistent and smart. I'm particularly interested in what the future may have in store for the power plant. I'm also interested in exploring ideas for additional sources of revenue for city administration. I look forward to the interview and the opportunity.
